I am very pleased to write this letter of recommendation for Changyun (PJ) Han, a rising senior at UT Austin, who is applying for internship at your company. I first met Changyun last year August when he enrolled into my FIN 357 (Business Finance) class. FIN 357 is an introductory finance course required for all UT business major students.

While enrolled in my class, Changyun served as a study group facilitator, which allowed me to interact with him more often than other students. Facilitators are hired as part of the Peer-Led Undergraduate Studying (PLUS) Program, which aims to assist students enrolled in historically difficult courses by offering class-specific, weekly study groups.
